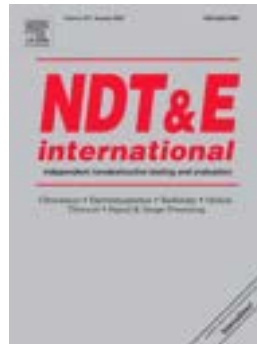

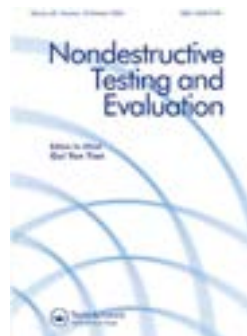

Authors of **high-quality contributions** will be invited to submit an extended and enhanced version of their work for consideration in these journals.

Authors are **strictly required** to present the paper's content during the conference. No-show contributions will **not** be included in the special issues.

The full paper submission procedure to the aforementioned Journals begins **one week after the conference closes and ends on August 24th, 2026.**

Publication fees may be applied, according to the Publisher's policy.

The submission procedure follows this pathway:

- Submission to **Research and Review Journal of Nondestructive Testing** is via the Authors portal in the official conference platform (<https://www.conftool.pro/ecndt2026/>)
- Submission to **NDT & E International, Nondestructive Testing and Evaluation, Structural Health Monitoring, Insight - Non-Destructive Testing and Condition Monitoring** is by means of the individual journal/publisher platforms.

Authors must ensure that all **full papers are original**. Papers must not have been previously submitted to any other journal or publisher. Authors are solely responsible for **complying with the self-archiving policy** of the journal to which the paper is submitted.

Authors also have the **option** to submit by April 10th a pre-print of the full paper for inclusion in the **conference proceedings** that will be made freely accessible on NDT.net's Open Access Archive in a

special issue of the e-Journal of Nondestructive Testing (ISSN 1435-4934) (www.ndt.net). The preprint of the full paper, unless otherwise agreed, is published under the CC-BY 4.0 license, to allow the widest distribution. In any case, **Authors are solely responsible for ensuring that including their preprint in the proceedings complies with the policies of the journal to which they intend to submit it for subsequent publication.**

We are proud to offer this valuable publication pathway, and we strongly encourage you to consider developing your conference paper for this opportunity.
